# Council of Lutheran Women President's Report - 2017

As I look back over the last year it is evident that God has blessed our organization mightily through its dedicated and faithful members. The Council now represents 80 churches and organizations with our newest member, Camp Restore, residing at Mt. Calvary, Detroit.

At last year's luncheon the Council honored 56 women from our member organizations and 917 men and women attended the luncheon. After lunch we were entertained by Rev. Rennie Kaufmann and his daughter Esther who sang a variety of music. The proceeds of the luncheon provided scholarships we awarded in September to the seminary and deaconess students from our member congregations. Scholarships went to 14 men who attend seminary and 1 woman in the deaconess program at Concordia University – Chicago. In addition, two memorial scholarships were awarded to women studying for church work careers at Concordia University—Ann Arbor.

The Council continues to support several mission projects. During the past year layettes were prepared and given to organizations that serve women with unplanned pregnancies. Detroit Lutheran food banks and the Detroit Rescue Mission Ministry were given contributions of food and paper products, bath and bed linens, and personal hygiene products. The Council is now reporting on all our inter-congregational members and letting everyone know their needs.

The Council continues to offer an opportunity for anyone to support the Council by contributing to our Sponsorship Program. This donation goes directly to the Scholarship Fund and is not used for expenses. Thank you to all who contributed to the sponsorship program this year. A donation may be made at any time during the year and will be recorded in the program booklet. See our website (clwmichigan.com) for instructions to donate to the sponsorship program.
