

Never in her wildest dreams did Gayle Sommerfeld imagine founding an international ministry. But after a glimpse of the



need in Haiti Gayle felt God's calling to respond. She and her husband Don's first mission trip was to Haiti and from there, over the next 30 years, they developed a ministry bringing healing and hope to a hurting world. Thousands have followed where she led through the ministry of Mission Opportunities Short Term – MOST Ministries.

Gayle, a wife, mother, grandmother

and great-grandmother, feels especially blessed when around her family. She is also involved with an organization, Dignity4Girls, which provides reusable personal hygiene kits to young women in third world countries.

It was a brief but profound glimpse of distant suffering that moved Gayle Sommerfeld, at the age of fifty, to begin an international ministry that would change the lives of more than 200,000 people on five continents. In Beyond Sight Gayle shares her and her husband's journey as they began Mission Opportunities Short Term – MOST Ministries – a ministry that has enabled over 4,000 volunteers to serve worldwide.

Walk with Gayle and her MOST Ministries team members as they learn to trust God while bringing hope and healing to impoverished Haitians, repurposed eyeglasses to India's leper colonies, hospice training to Latvia and much more. 

Council of Lutheran Women President's Report - 2018

In assuming the role of President of the Council of Lutheran Women this past year, I continue to be amazed at what is accomplished through the combined efforts of the member congregations and organizations. In 2018 the Council honored 55 women from our member organizations as our Women of the Year but we have been blessed with so many dedicated members. For this reason, we are now referring to this event as the Council of Lutheran Women Luncheon. It will continue to include the honoring of Women of the Year selected by those congregations and organizations that choose to do so, but we wish to acknowledge and applaud all the thousands of members throughout our area who support the ministry efforts of the Council.

The proceeds of last year's luncheon along with generous support from Church Extension Fund, Thrivent, and other organizations and individuals allowed us to grant scholarships to 17 seminarians, including one deaconess student, and two memorial scholarships for two young ladies at Concordia University - Ann Arbor who are preparing for church work careers.

The Council continues to support several mission projects. Each year layettes are prepared and given to organizations that serve mothers in need of assistance. Over \$1,300 was shared with Detroit Lutheran Food Banks, along with contributions of food and paper products, personal hygiene items, clothing and many other items needed by our inter-congregational members. The Council website has been focusing on these groups and their needs to keep our membership better informed on how we can support these groups.

The Council has now received its letter of determination from the IRS to verify that we are a 501(c)(3) organization. This also allowed us to become a recipient of Thrivent Choice Dollars. We are continuing to offer a Sponsorship Program for anyone wishing to contribute towards the seminarian scholarships. Donations may be made at any time during the year and will be recorded in the program booklet. See our website (clwmichigan.com) for instructions to donate to the sponsorship program.
